Official Tournament Rules

Your signature(s) on the entry form attest that both boater and partner have read and understand the following rules and further that you both agree to abide by the same.

- **1. Rules and Decisions:** Interpretation of rules is at discretion of Tournament Officials and shall be final. Your signature on the entry form is your agreement to abide by all rules as stated.
- **2. Eligibility**: Boater must be 18 yrs. or older. Partners under 18 yrs. of age must have parent or legal guardian's signature on entry form. Tournament Officials have the right to refuse any entry. High School teams with a boater captain will be allowed to fish in this event, boater captains cannot fish during the tournament.
- 3. Entries: Two-man team mandatory for safety. \$70 per boat, includes \$5.00 for Big Bass. 100% payback for big bass. Starting position determined by date and time entry is received. Mailed entries must be received by Monday, February 6tht at 5 pm. Entries will be accepted at the ramp (CASH only) until 6 am Saturday morning but a \$20 late fee will be assessed. Late fees will not be included in payout.
- 4. Boat, Tackle, and Equipment: Boat only tournament. Boat must meet all state and federal regulations for horsepower and safety requirements. Must have an operating engine kill switch and the lanyard must be attached to driver whenever the engine is running. Boats must have functional live wells. Contestants must wear life jackets any time engine is running. No

wake and off-limits areas must be obeyed. No alcohol or drug use allowed. Unsportsmanlike or unsafe acts will result in disqualification. Artificial baits only except for pork baits. All bass must be caught on rod and reel and only one rod and reel per person may be used at a time. No trolling allowed with outboard motor.

- **5. Fish and Scoring:** Largemouth, spotted and smallmouth bass only. Five (5) fish limit per team. Culling must happen immediately. All bass must be 12" or greater. Each Team can weigh one (1) fish over 22 inches. Short fish will be penalized one (1) pound. Keep your catch alive. Dead fish will be assessed a one (1) pound penalty. Ties will be broken with the number of fish, then largest fish.
- **6. Check-in and Take-off:** All boats must check in at the ramp by 6:45 am. Do not launch until you have been checked by a Tournament Official. Boat check will start at 5:45 am. Boats not checked in prior to take-off will not be allowed to weigh in and will forfeit their entry fee. Take-off time will be at 7:00 am or safe light.
- 7. Weigh-in: All boats must be in the weigh-in area by designated time. Any boat arriving late will be disqualified. First flight weighs in at 2:45 pm, second flight weighs in at 3:00 pm. Fish must be brought to weigh-in in bags provided by Tournament Officials. Anglers are responsible to ensure their weights are recorded properly. Protests must be made immediately after the last fish are weighed. Protest will be judged by the Tournament Officials. All decisions are final.
